2025 CanSAGE Meeting Recap

The 2025 CanSAGE Meeting welcomed 277 participants, including practicing minimally invasive gynecologic surgeons, clinician educators, trainees (fellows, residents, and medical students), as well as fellowship and program directors. Among the attendees were 123 practicing physicians, 74 trainees, and 24 invited speakers.

The event featured national representation from across Canada, with the majority of participants coming from Ontario, Saskatchewan, Québec, British Columbia, and Alberta. Additionally, 15 international attendees joined from outside Canada.
